BEQUESTS

A bequest is the gifting of assets through a will or an estate plan. A specific bequest bequeaths a certain dollar amount or certain other property. The following types of bequests are most commonly used:

- ♥ **Specific Bequest:** Gifting a specific asset or dollar amount
- ♥ **Percentage Bequest:** Gifting a percentage of an estate
- ♥ **Residual Bequest:** Gifting the remaining balance after specific bequests have been distributed
- ♥ **Contingent Bequest:** Gifting made a charity only when the primary beneficiary cannot accept the gift.
