Beneficiary Designation

Beneficiary designations allow you to transfer assets directly, regardless of the terms of your will. Beneficiary designations are often made when a financial account, retirement account, or life insurance policy is established.

- ♥ **No Probate:** allow assets to pass directly to whomever you designate, bypassing the costs and time involved with the probate process.
- ♥ **Flexible:** Beneficiary designations are easy to make and relatively easy to change.
- ♥ **Easy:** Reduces the burden of taxes on your family.
- ♥ **Tax Deductible:** You may receive an estate tax charitable deduction.
